

Directions for Liquid Measurement Cards

Traditional teaching lesson

1. Print out 2 copies of cards and laminate.

Print out one copy of equivalent measurement cards and laminate for durability.

Print out one copy and leave cards attached, but cut around margins to create a control card.

Place the "measurement" and "equivalent measurement" heading cards in the top-center of the workspace.

Stack the measurement cards in a pile to the right of the workspace.

Place the "equivalent measurement" cards in a pile to the right of the workspace, under the measurement cards.

Lay out all the measurement cards in a column under the "time heading card"

Find the matching equivalent time card and place it to the right of the time card, under the "equivalent measurement" heading card.



Check answers with control card when finished.

Alternate learning idea:

Use the cards to play a "concentration" style game where all cards (except heading cards) are placed face down on the workspace and child turns two over at a time to find a match.
