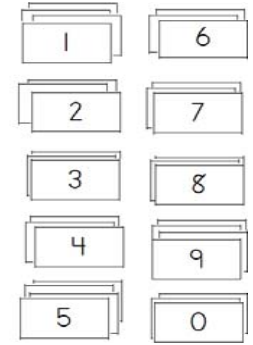
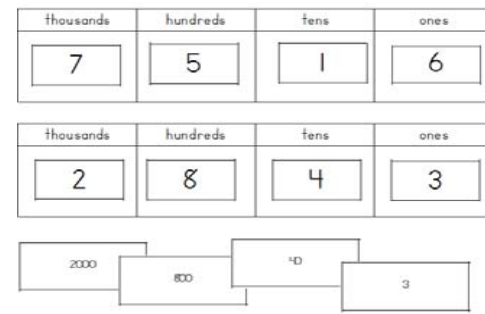


Directions:

1. Print/cut out place value chart, digit cards, and number cards.
2. Laminate for durability.
3. Put place value chart in the middle of the workspace.
4. Place digit cards and number cards in piles to the right of the workspace.
5. Separate number cards (i.e. 200, 30, 4, 1) into separate piles according to color.

All orange cards are one pile, all purple cards are another pile.

6. Choose a pile to start with. For example, the orange pile
7. Pick up an orange card - if it is the 200 orange card, the child should place a "2" digit card in the hundreds place value chart. If the child picks up an orange card with 40 on it, the child should place a "4" digit card in the tens place value spot on the chart.
8. Repeat the same procedure with the other color piles.
